

Memorial Day 2010



On May 31, 2010, Mayor Ed Zimmerman officiated at the dedication of the new Memorial Garden at Panicaro Park. In Mayor Zimmerman's remarks he thanked the committee of residents who helped in conceptualizing the latest addition to the park. The committee was headed by Council Member Mark Pausch. The group included Tamara Lee (a certified landscape architect and the Borough's recently appointed Planner) who designed the Memorial Garden in concert with Rocky Hill residents, Peggy Harris, Michael Goldman, Mary

Germain and Sam Panicaro. Participating with the committee and overseeing the construction was the Borough Engineer, William Tanner. The funds used for the construction of the Memorial Garden came from a grant from Somerset County. In the coming weeks the Memorial Garden will be completed with the illumination of the flagpole.

Mayor Zimmerman and a number of residents gathered in the Memorial Garden to honor our armed forces, both past and present, who have served and are continuing to serve their country. Reverend Linda Pepe, the Pastor of the First Reformed Church, gave a homily.
