

Explanation: This ordinance repeals in its entirety Chapter 50, entitled “Alarms,” of the Code of the Borough of Rocky Hill. The Mayor and Council of the Borough of Rocky Hill have determined that the regulation of alarm systems within the Borough of Rocky Hill is not needed.

Ordinance #12, 2010

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING IN ITS ENTIRETY CHAPTER 50, ENTITLED “ALARMS,” OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF ROCKY HILL. THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF ROCKY HILL HAVE DETERMINED THAT THE REGULATION OF ALARM SYSTEMS WITHIN THE BOROUGH OF ROCKY HILL IS NOT NEEDED.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Rocky Hill, County of Somerset, State of New Jersey, that Chapter 50 of the Code of the Borough of Rocky Hill, entitled “Alarms,” is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Section 1. Chapter 50, entitled “Alarms,” of the Code of the Borough of Rocky Hill is hereby repealed.

Section 2. Should any provision of this ordinance be determined invalid by a court or administrative tribunal of competent jurisdiction, such determination shall not affect the remaining provisions.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication as required by law.
