- Re a possible public health project for the Board, Mr. Strong presented preliminary information on the State Partnership for Nutrition, Physical Activity and Obesity Prevention. This new 5-year initiative is funded by CDC through the State. He will have further information by the time of the next meeting.

- Animal Control: A resident has recently call South Brunswick Animal control about a concern. It was decided that the Board should receive timely reports when there is Animal control activity. Dr. Haines will follow up.
