

**NOTICE OF INTRODUCTION – ORDINANCE #11, 2010  
“CIRCUSES AND CARNIVALS”  
OF THE  
CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF ROCKY HILL**

Please take notice that the following Ordinance #11, 2010, was introduced at a regular meeting of the Borough Council of the Borough of Rocky Hill, held on November 15, 2010, and was read for the first time. **AN ORDINANCE REPEALING IN ITS ENTIRETY CHAPTER 74, ENTITLED “CIRCUSES AND CARNIVALS,” OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF ROCKY HILL. CHAPTER 74 WAS ENACTED IN 1915 WHEN TRAVELING SHOWS AND EXHIBITIONS WERE COMMONPLACE AND REQUIRED REGULATION. SINCE THAT TIME, NOT ONLY HAVE SUCH ACTIVITIES BECOME RARE, BUT ALSO THE BOROUGH OF ROCKY HILL HAS ENACTED OTHER ORDINANCES REGULATING THE USE OF ITS OPEN SPACE OR PARKLAND. ACCORDINGLY, THE MAYOR AND BOROUGH COUNCIL HAVE DETERMINED THAT CHAPTER 74 SHOULD BE REPEALED.** This Ordinance will be posted at the Rocky Hill Post Office and the Mary Jacobs Library, and copies are available in the office of the Borough Clerk at the Borough Hall. This Ordinance will be further considered for final passage on second reading following a public hearing at a regular meeting of the Mayor and Council beginning at 7:30 PM on December 6, 2010, at the Borough Hall located at 15 Montgomery Ave., Rocky Hill, NJ, or at any time and place to which such meeting may be adjourned. All persons interested will be given the opportunity to be heard concerning such ordinance.
